Him bending) are sung.*

Holy Trinity, one God, in you we live and move and have our being.
We praise and bless you, O Lord.

Lord, grant your healing grace to all who are sick,
injured or disabled, that they may be made whole.
Hear us, O Lord of life.

Heal them, O Lord of Life.

Hear us, O Lord of life.

Restore to wholeness whatever is broken by human sin, in our lives, in our nation, and in the world.

Hear us, O Lord of life.

You are the Lord who does mighty wonders.

You have declared your power among the peoples.

With you, Lord, is the well of life and in your light do we see light.

Bring healing and restoration for all whom we now pray.

Hear us, O Lord of life: heal them and make them whole.

O Lord our God, accept the fervent prayers of your people; in the multitude of your mercies look with compassion upon us and all who turn to you for help; for you are gracious,

O lover of souls, and to you we give glory,

Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, now and for ever. Amen.

Here follows a period of Adoration

After the period of Adoration is said the following

V: Thou gavest them bread from heaven. (Alleluia).

R: Containing in itself all sweetness. (Alleluia).

V. Let us pray. O God, who in a wonderful Sacrament hast left us a memorial of thy Passion: grant that me may so reverence the sacred mysteries of thy Body and Blood; that we may ever enjoy within ourselves the fruit of thy redemption: Who livest and reignst, world without end. Amen.

Then are said the Divine Praises

Blessed be God.

Blessed be his holy Name.

Blessed be Jesus Christ, true God and true Man.

Blessed be the Name of Jesus.

Blessed be his most sacred Heart.

Blessed be Jesus in the most holy Sacrament of the Altar

Blessed be the great Mother of God, Mary most holy.

Blessed be her holy and Immaculate Conception.

Blessed be her glorious Assumption.

Blessed be the name of Mary, Virgin and Mother.

Blessed be Saint Joseph, her Spouse most chaste.

Blessed be God in his Angels and in his Saints.

As the Sacrament is returned to the tabernacle the Adoro te devote is sung.

Humbly I adore thee, Verity unseen,
Who thy glory hidest 'neath these shadows mean;
Lo, to thee surrendered, my whole heart is bowed,
Tranced as it beholds thee, shrined within the cloud.

Taste and touch and vision to discern thee fail;
Faith, that comes by hearing, pierces through the veil.
I believe whate'er the Son of God hath told;
What the Truth hath spoken, that for truth I hold.

O memorial wondrous of the Lord's own death;
Living Bread, which givest all thy creatures breath,
Grant my spirit ever by thy life may live,
To my taste thy sweetness never-failing give.

Jesus, by Heav'n veiled, I perceive by faith;
What my soul doth thirst for, do not, Lord, forsake:
That thy face unveiled, I at last may see,
With the blissful vision, blest my God, of thee.
